



## **EDUCATION INTERN EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANT**

### **DESCRIPTION**

The Palos Verdes Peninsula Land Conservancy manages 1600 acres of open space that are predominantly coastal sage scrub habitat, along with grassland and riparian habitats. The habitats are found in preserves throughout the Palos Verdes Peninsula and include the White Point Nature Preserve in San Pedro, the George F Canyon and Linden H. Chandler Preserves in Rolling Hills Estates, and the 1200-acre Palos Verdes Nature Preserve in Rancho Palos Verdes. The Conservancy also manages two nature centers featuring the local flora and fauna and natural history in interactive exhibits. All are destination points for educational field trips.

An Educational Assistant will work under the direction of the Education Director to assist in preparing for and conducting educational field trips. The clients are predominantly elementary students ranging from kindergarten to 6<sup>th</sup> grade. The field trips are designed to cover California State Science Standards and are presented in an experiential learning setting.

- Availability on Wednesdays and Fridays, 8:00 am to noon
- Familiarity with local native plants and animals
- Major in natural sciences (e.g. environmental science, geology, biology, geography) and/or teaching
