# STEWARDSHIP INTERN FIELD & NURSERY TECHNICIAN

### DESCRIPTION

The Palos Verdes Peninsula Land Conservancy manages over 1600 acres of open space on the Palos Verdes Peninsula. PVPLC maintains a work crew to manage and restore the native habitat in the open space. Student interns will have the opportunity to obtain hands-on experience with native habitat maintenance and restoration activities.

A Field & Nursery Technician will work under the direction of the Stewardship Manager to assist with a variety of habitat restoration projects. Tasks vary greatly and can include aiding in the management of nature preserves, native species planting, invasive plant control, native seed collection, plant identification, and plant propagation.

### REQUIREMENTS

- 18 years or older with an interest in restoration, environmental sciences and/or native plants
- Familiarity with coastal sage scrub native plants and animals
- Able to do substantial amounts of strenuous work in the field
- Ability to work independently
