



CONSERVATION INTERN GPS AND GIS MAPPING

DESCRIPTION

The Palos Verdes Peninsula Land Conservancy manages over 1500 acres of open space on the Palos Verdes Peninsula. Part of the management activities includes habitat restoration and monitoring. PVPLC utilizes GPS in these activities and maintains a GIS program of the preserves it manages.

A GIS & Mapping Intern will work under the direction of a Stewardship Associate to assist with mapping on a variety of projects conducted within the preserves. Tasks are varied and can include conducting GPS data collection during field surveys, updating current maps, and developing new maps. Also the GPS & Mapping Intern will work closely with the Wildlife Research Intern.

REQUIREMENTS

- Currently enrolled in a college or university as a junior, senior, or graduate student
- Familiarity with using GPS units
- Familiarity with ESRI GIS version 9.3
- Familiarity with coastal sage scrub native plants and animals
- Ability to work independently
